ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL ROUTINES

If someone else is picking up your child from school, please put it in writing with the person's full name. They will be asked for identification (driver's license, state ID) upon pick up and a copy will be made to keep on file.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is important to a successful school year.

All parents will sign an attendance contract at the beginning of the year indicating the expectations Beard has for children. Our goal is 95% attendance or higher for all students.
