

K-3rd Grade School Donation Supply List

- Each child should have a **regular size backpack** that they carry to school every day. Please do not get the very small backpacks. Please place a label on the inside of the backpack with your child's full name, address, parent contact phone number, and bus route and company information if your child rides the bus.
- Change of clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks) - labeled with the child's name in a gallon size Ziploc bag to be kept at school. Also include an extra face mask in a sealed ziploc bag in case an extra is needed.
- Your child should bring a reusable water bottle **labeled with their name for daily use**.
- If your child will be bringing their lunch they will need a lunch bag **labeled with their name**.
- Please send a 4x6 picture of your family with your child in it.
- 1 Sterilite plastic shoe box filled with: (Sterilite brand shoe box is available at Target)
 - 3 clear or purple glue sticks
 - 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
 - 1 pack of Crayola markers
 - 1 pack of dry erase markers
 - 4 pack of play dough
 - 8 1/2 x 11 Dry Erase Board
- White Velcro Dots - You can get these on amazon.com for the best deal
- 3 large containers of Clorox or Lysol Wipes
- 2 cans of Lysol spray or
- Disinfectant surface cleaning spray -2 bottles
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 4 Rolls of Select-a-Size Paper Towels
- 1 package of Command photo hanging strips
- 1 package of Command hooks
- 2 packs of baby wipes
- Ziploc bags, 1 box of each – gallon, quart, sandwich
- 4 bags of dollar store party favor toys/trinkets for our treasure box. Children can earn treasure box items each week.
- Wooden or paper mache letter of the first initial of your child's name: minimum of 5 inches (can be found at Michael's, Joann or Hobby Lobby. Letters will be decorated by your child and attached to the wall in the classroom to create a classroom collage.

- Luggage tag attached to your child's backpack - on the inside. Write the first and last name of your child and parent cell and home phone number on the tag. If your child takes the bus, include the name of company and route.
- 2" Binder (to travel daily in backpack, must fit in backpack)
- Hand soap – 2 bottles
- Band-Aids
- Paper plates
